



...to create a vegie garden at home

This spring all you need to start growing your own vegetable garden is a foam box!

Foam boxes are light and easy for you and your kids to manage.

Step One: Cut six drainage holes in the bottom of the foam box.

Step Two: Elevate foam box by placing it on some old bricks and fill with potting mix.



Step Three: Plant seedlings or seeds, making sure not to over plant (aim to plant around 4-6 seedlings per box).

Step Four: Water and care for your seedlings daily.

Try planting tomato, pumpkin and zucchini seedlings this spring...and watch your kids enjoy eating the results!

Students from Tuntable Creek Public School will again be participating in the School Swimming Scheme at Lismore Memorial Baths with qualified swim instructors from the Department of Education & Communities. The program will commence on Monday 5 November and conclude on Friday 14 November 2014.

To keep costs to a minimum, students will travel by bus with students from The Channon PS. The Channon PS has kindly offered to pay for all costs associated with the hire of the bus from The Channon PS to Lismore Memorial Baths.
