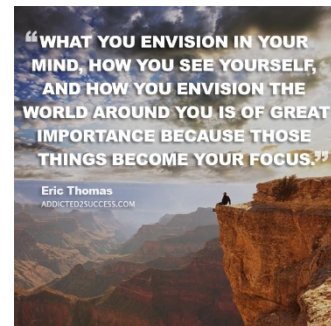

Later this week, Miss Jodie, Mrs Bennett and I will organize and set out goals we would like students to talk to parents about around literacy and maths. As you have probably already guessed, knowing time- tables will be a number one priority. What we are noticing is that students can recite them and use great strategies to work out difficult ones, but are not automatic in their responses when presented with mixed problems nor in using multiplication to solve division.

By the end of Year 4, students should know up to 10 x 10 tables with automaticity.

Testing for strengths and learning needs will be this week's focus so that intensive planning and goal setting can go ahead.

From a test last week, we realized that while we know about contractions ie can't; shouldn't; we need to be more aware of reading and writing them correctly to ensure the sentence makes sense. A couple of notorious ones are- it's and its, your and you're. So we had some fun this morning putting them into our writing. I really love how creative the students have become in their writing.
