This term we are starting the Program Become.Me for Stage 3 students. As a school, we did the first lesson together as it fitted in beautifully with our Strengths-Based approach learning. Student Outcomes were:

I will reflect on myself as a unique, valuable individual

I will understand that we can break out of the stories that we tell or hear about ourselves

I will recognise that one person's interests and values can change over time

BECOME.ME empowers young people with the skills to explore, design and navigate their own unique future. In a world of rapid and constant change, where a lifetime of learning and course adjustments will be the new normal, acquiring the skills to design (and frequently re-design) your life has never been so essential. The program enables us to deliver a student-centred, personalised experience through the innovative become.me digital tool.

The program is designed around three key learning domains. Success is the mastery of these skills that will be needed throughout life. Focusing on a single decision at a fixed moment in time is too little, too late to prepare young people for a lifetime of learning.

Awareness

Students become active explorers of their dynamic self and the changing world of work. They learn to recognise stereotypes and influences on their ideas for their future.

Aspiration

Students create motivating possibilities for themselves and share those ideas with parents and teachers. They connect what they're learning to those possibilities - putting their own 'why' into what they're learning.

Agency

Students practice the adaptive skills and experimentation they'll use through a lifetime of learning and course adjustments. Design thinking applied to the most relevant problem of all - them!
