## Festival of the famous

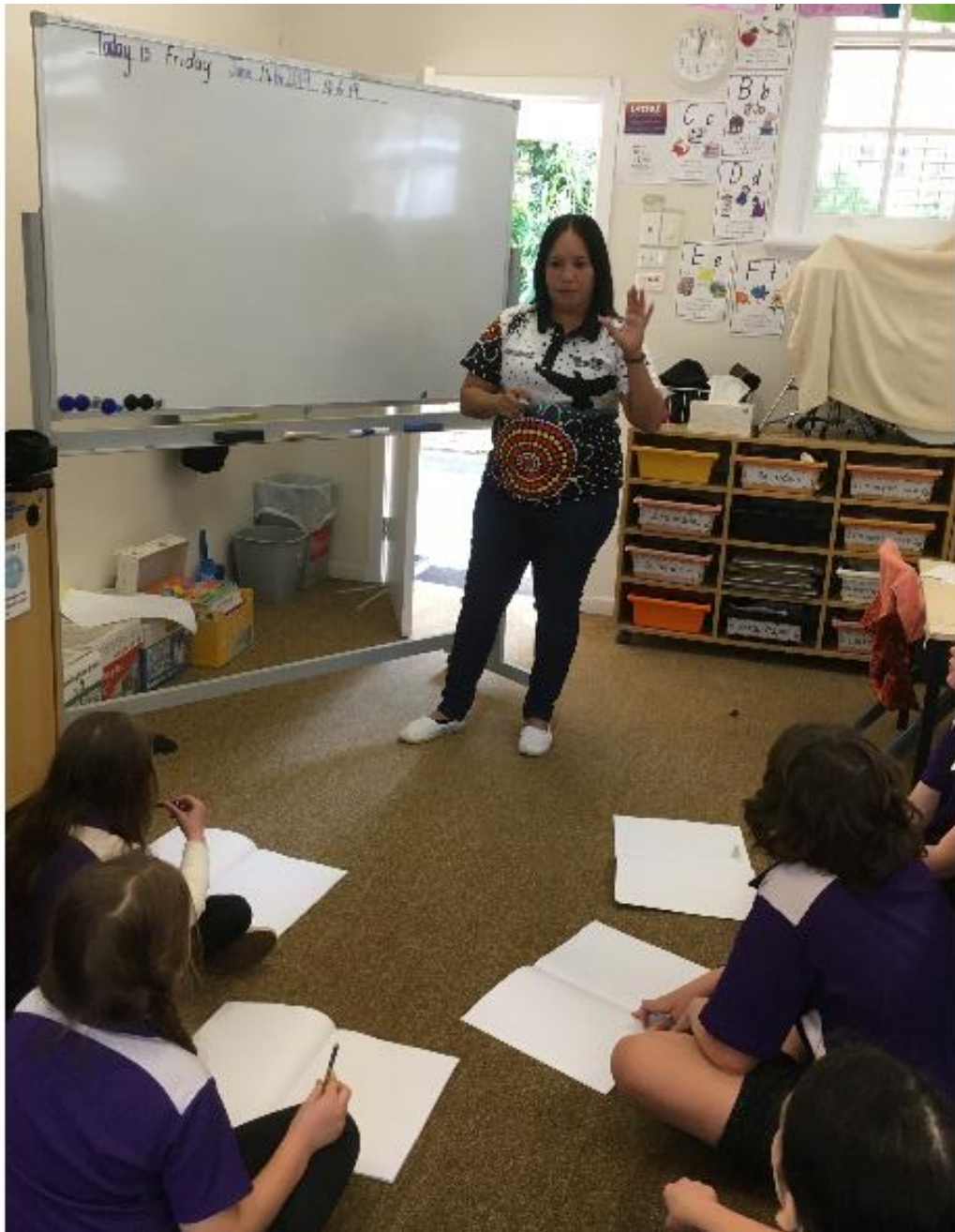
Students have been working hard at home and at school on their Festival of the Famous presentations. The presentations are due in on Monday June 24<sup>th</sup> 2019.

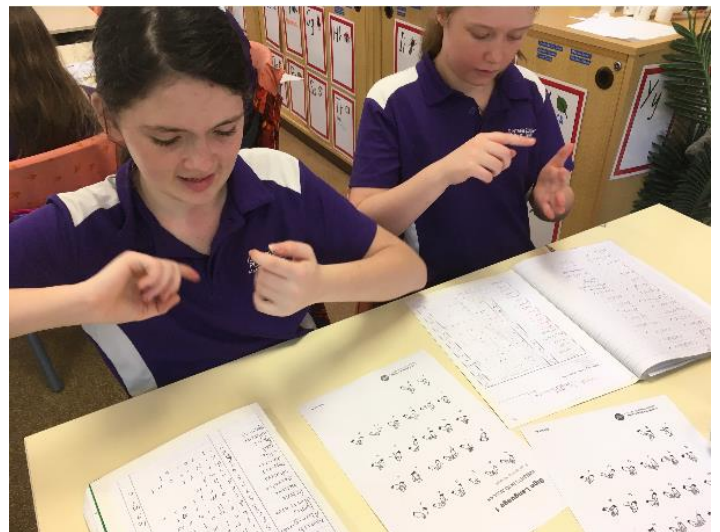
## Bundjalung Language Program
