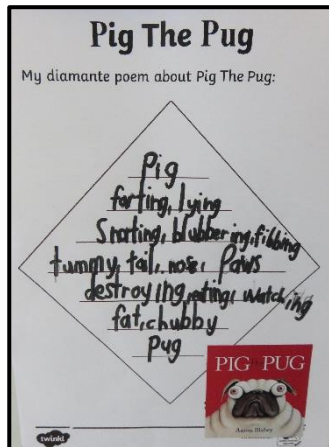
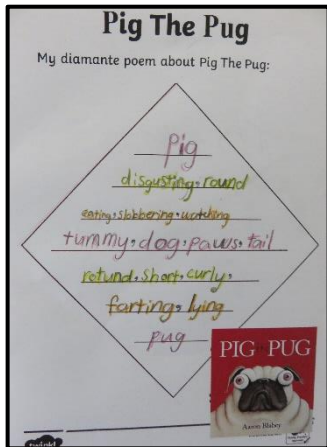
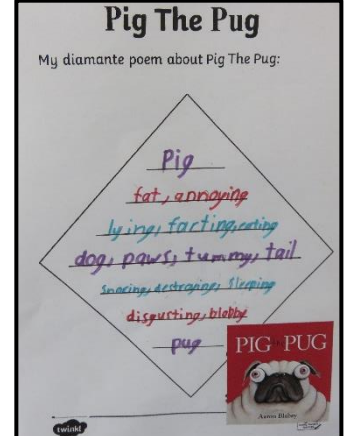
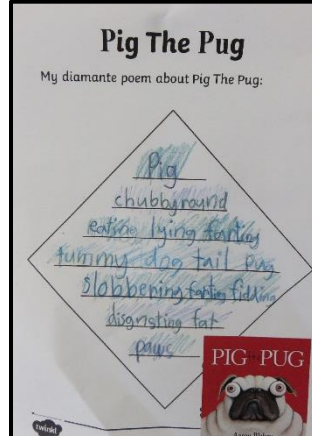
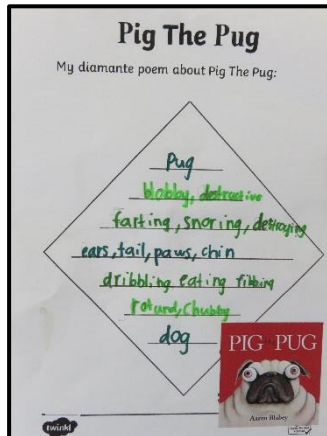
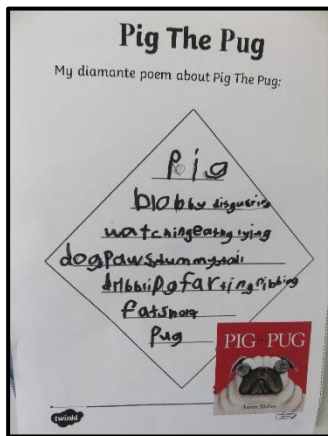
Reminder:

- Social skills of honesty and inclusion in Rhythm to Recovery
