



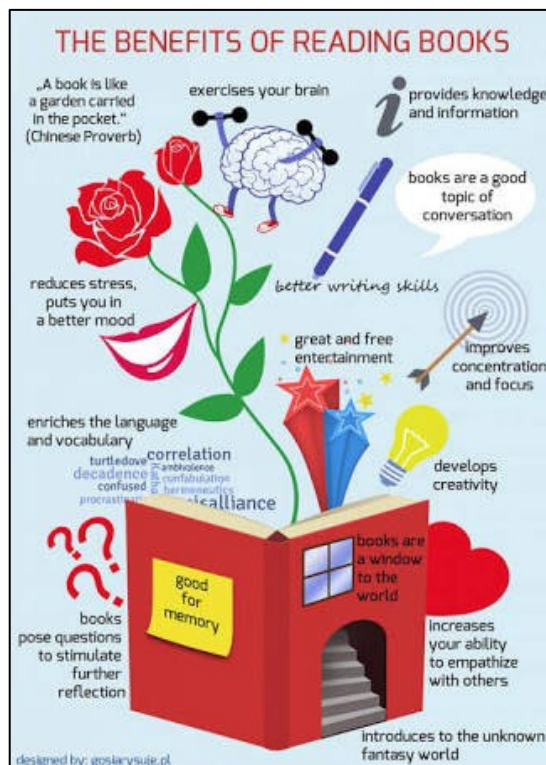
Hi everyone,

 act.



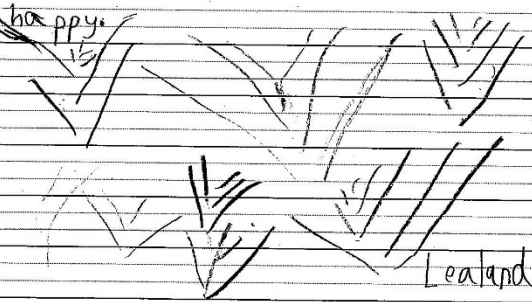
Lismore Show 21.10.22

Fire Works 22.10.22

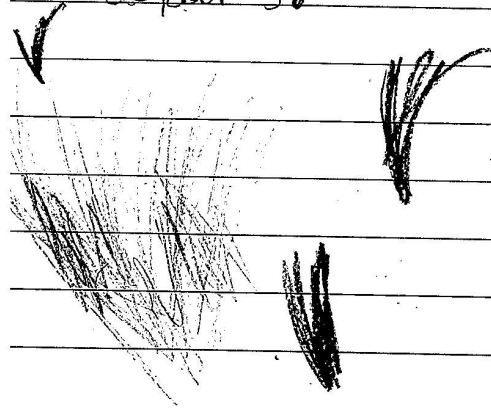

Fire Works 25.10.22

Fire works are cylinders packed with gun
powder and special chemicals. When you light
them on fire they launch into the sky and
explode. When they explode thousands of
rainbow star like sparkles flutter in the sky. ✓

Fire works get their colour from special
chemicals. Sodium produces yellow, strontium is
red, copper and barium ^{make} blue and green. If
charcoal is added the fire works get flaming
tails. Some fire works don't have colour and
are only used for noise. They are called
fire crackers.

because they went boom, crackle, boom, really
